

CARGO HANDLED AT MAJOR PORTS DURING AND UP TO JUNE, 2017

Total Cargo traffic at India's Major Ports

Maritime transport activity is driven by developments in world economy, viz, growth in world output and trade. Thus volume of seaborne cargo traffic handled by ports is mainly shaped by the levels and changes in both the global and domestic activity. Cargo traffic at India's 12 major ports during **April-June, 2017, increased by 5.0% to 167.29 million tonnes** from 159.26 million tonnes handled during April-June, 2016.

Port-wise Cargo traffic handled during June, 2017

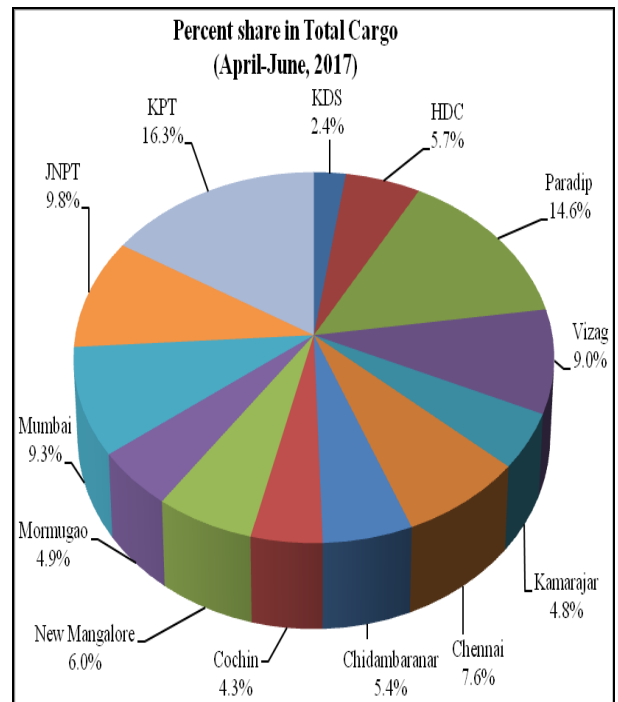
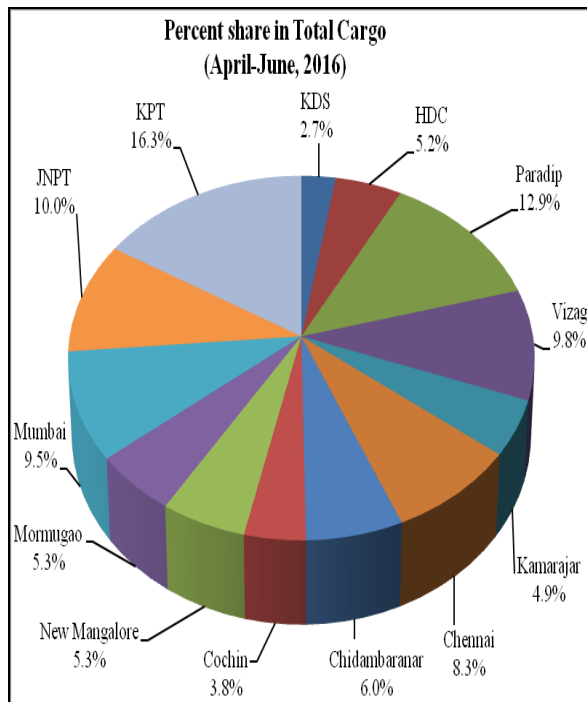
- Cargo handled at India's major ports during June, 2017 at 53.87 million tonnes increased by 4.6% compared to growth of 6.0% in the corresponding period of the previous year.
- During **June, 2017**, New Mangalore Port posted highest growth in traffic of 45.2% followed by Paradip Port (25.3%), Cochin Port (16.3%), Haldia Dock Complex (15.2%), Mumbai Port (4.9%) and Chennai Port (1.1%). The **major ports which recorded negative growth in June, 2017** viz: Mormugao Port (23.4%) followed by Chidambaranar Port (16.6%), Vishakhapatnam Port (3.4%), Kandla Port (3.1%), Kolkata Dock System (1.4%), JNPT (1.0%) and Kamarajar Port (0.9%).
- Amongst the 12 major ports, Kandla Port handled the maximum cargo traffic at 8.3 million tonnes with a share of (15.5%) in the total cargo handled at Major Ports followed by Paradip Port (15.3%), JNPT (9.5%), Vishakhapatnam (9.5%), Mumbai (8.9%), Chennai (8.6%), New Mangalore Port Trust (7.0%), Haldia Dock Complex (6.2%), Chidambaranar (5.4%), Kamarajar (4.7%), Cochin (4.6%), Mormugao Port (2.4%) and Kolkata Dock System (2.4%).
- At a broad commodity level, **Iron Ore achieved highest growth of 33.7%** in June, 2017 followed by POL (16.1%), Other Commodity (10.5%) and Container (3.7%). Coal recorded negative growth of 16.3% followed by Fertilizer & FRM (8.4%).

Cargo traffic handled during April-June, 2017

- During the April-June, 2017-18, Paradip Port recorded highest growth in traffic at 18.6% followed by Cochin Port (18.3%), New Mangalore Port (17.4%), Haldia Dock Complex (15.3%), Kandla Port (4.4%), Kamarajar Port (2.9%), JNPT (2.8%) and Mumbai Port (2.8%). **Major ports that recorded negative growth in traffic during April-June, 2017-18 were:** Chidambaranar Port (5.8%), Kolkata Dock System (5.0%), Chennai Port (3.5%), Vishakhapatnam (3.2%) and Mormugao Port (2.2%) over April-June, 2016-17.

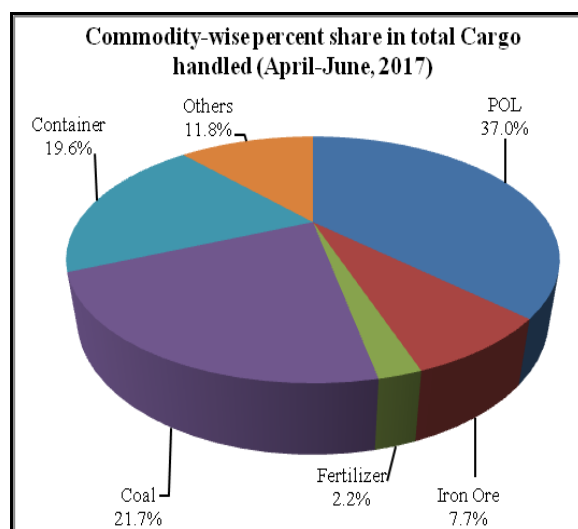
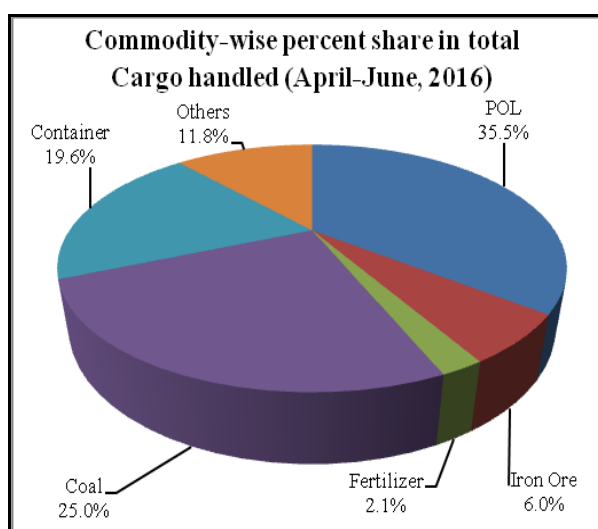

- Amongst the Major Ports, Kandla Port handled the maximum Cargo of 27.19 million tonnes with a share of 16.3% followed by Paradip (14.6%), JNPT (9.7%), Mumbai Port (9.3%), Vishakhapatnam (9.0%), Chennai Port (7.6%), New Mangalore Port (5.9%), Haldia Dock Complex (5.7%), Chidambaranar (5.4%), Mormugao Port (4.9%), Kamarajar (4.8%), Cochin (4.3%) and Kolkata Dock System (2.4%) during April-June, 2017-18.

- At a broad commodity group level during April-June, 2017, Iron ore, POL, Fertilizer & FRM, Other Cargo and Container posted growth of 33.4%, 9.6%, 6.9%, 5.6% and 5.4% respectively. Coal recorded negative growth of 9.0% during April-June, 2017.
- In the liquid bulk category, i.e. crude & petroleum cargo, the growth was 9.6% during April-June, 2017 compared to 2.4% growth in the corresponding period of previous year.
- Container handled at Major Ports, which reflects trade in manufactures has increased by 5.4% during April- June, 2017 compared to 3.1% growth during April-June, 2016.
- Growth in 'Other commodity' traffic has moderated to 5.6% during April-June, 2017 compared to growth of 10.1% during corresponding period of the previous year.
- Iron Ore cargo has posted robust growth of 33.4% during April-June, 2017 compared to robust growth of 159.3% during April-June, 2016 due to restarting of Iron Ore mining in Goa.
- In terms of composition of cargo traffic handled at major ports, the largest commodity group (with share in percent in total cargo handled) was POL (37.0%), Coal (21.7%), Container traffic (19.6%), other cargo (11.8%), Iron ore (7.7%) and Fertilizer & FRM (2.2%) during April-June, 2017.
