OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject – **Removal of cap for short listing of Bidders at RFQ stage for the PPP projects of the port sector**

As per the existing Guidelines for Pre-Qualification of Bidders for PPP projects as incorporated under Clause 3.5.2 of the RFQ document issued by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance vide O.M. No. 24(1)/PF-II/06 dated 18.5.2009, there is a provision for short listing of upto six pre-qualified applicants on the basis of their respective Aggregate Experience Scores for participation in the bidding stage.

2 Since the pre-qualification criteria of the RFQ document in clause 3.5.2 above has been hindering the selection of bidders for the PPP projects, it has been decided to remove the above mentioned cap for short listing of applicants in the port sector with immediate effect.

This issues with the approval of the Minister of Shipping.
