

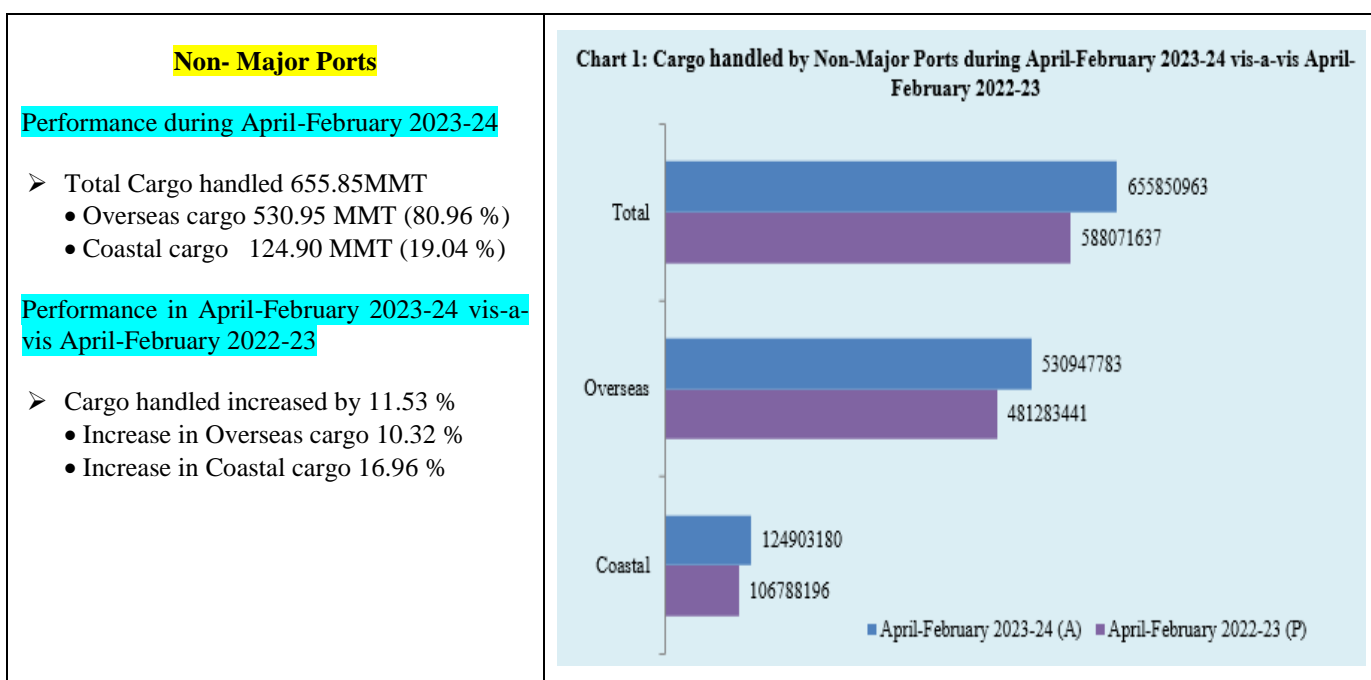

Cargo handled by Non-Major Ports in India

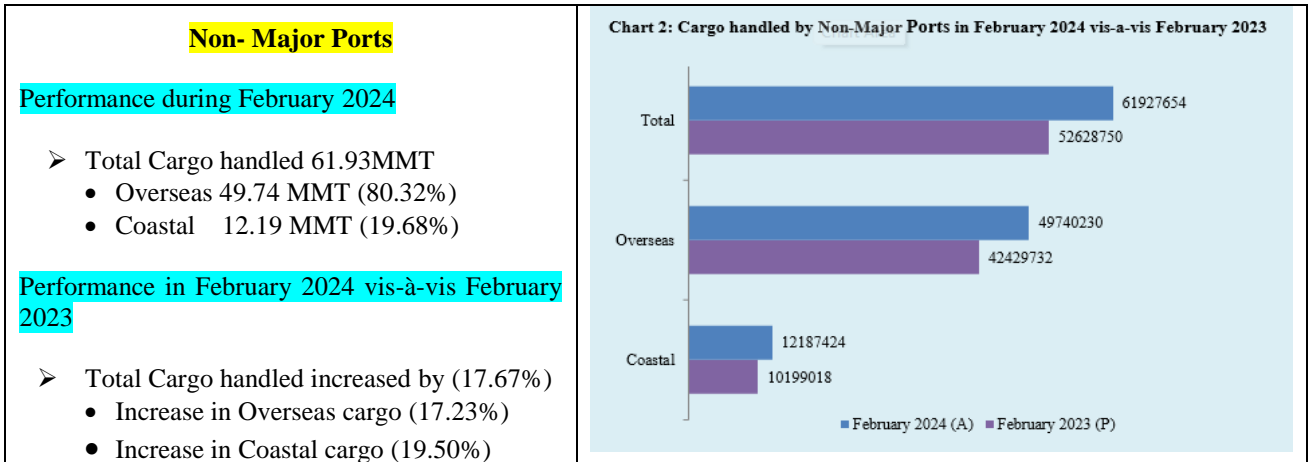
Maritime transport activity is driven by the growth in output and trade worldwide. The volume of seaborne cargo handled by ports is comprised of the global (i.e. overseas cargo) and domestic (i.e. coastal cargo) activities. There are 64 Non-Major ports under 10 State Maritime Boards (SMB) and Directorates of Ports (DoP) which provides information on Port Data Management Portal (PDMP) of Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways on cargo handled by them.

This edition provides advanced estimates for 2023-24 compared with provisional estimates of 2022-23. During April-February 2023-24 cargo handled at Non-Major Ports has increased by 11.53% as compared to April-February 2022-23. During April-February 2023-24 total cargo handled had increased to 655.85 million tonnes (MMT) from 588.07 MMT handled during April-February 2022-23.

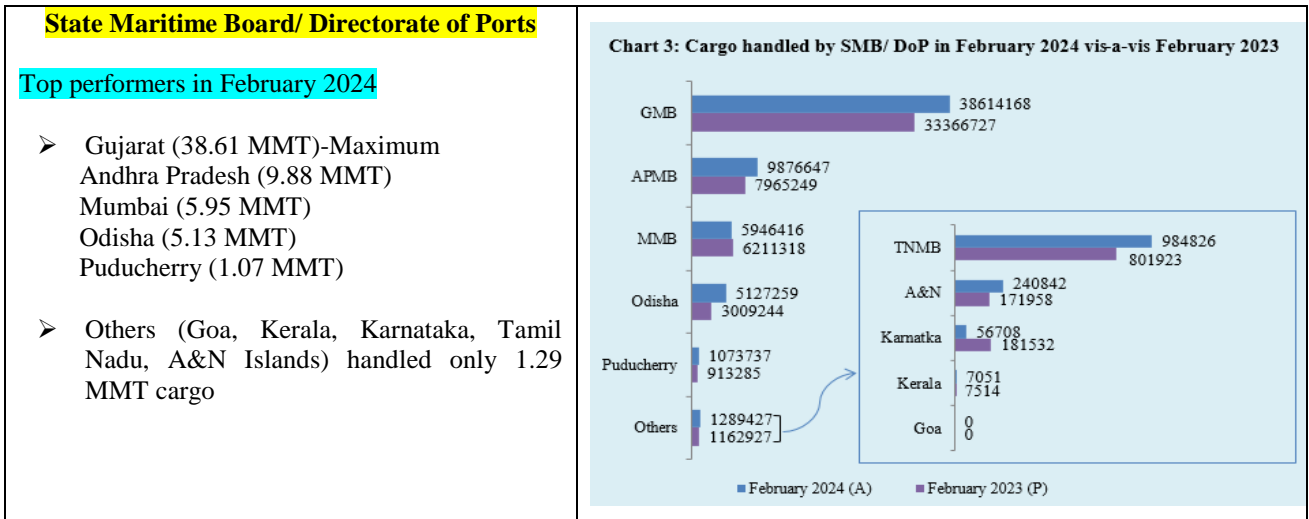
Cargo handled by Non-Major Ports during April-February 2023-24



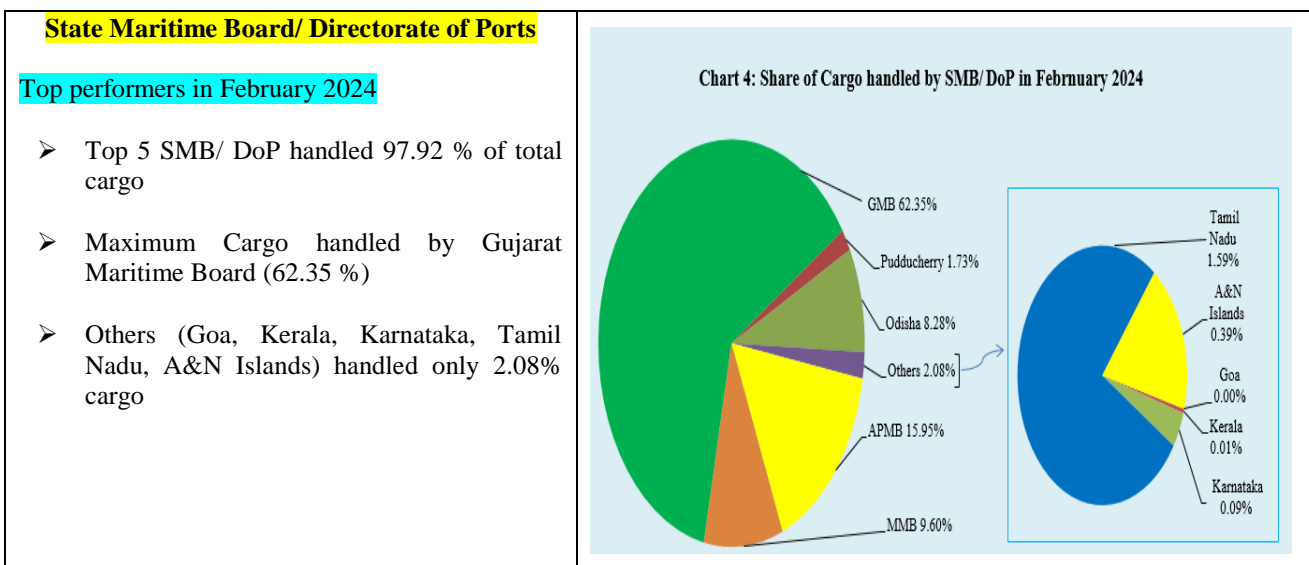
Cargo handled by Non-Major ports in February 2024

Commodity-wise Cargo handled in February 2024

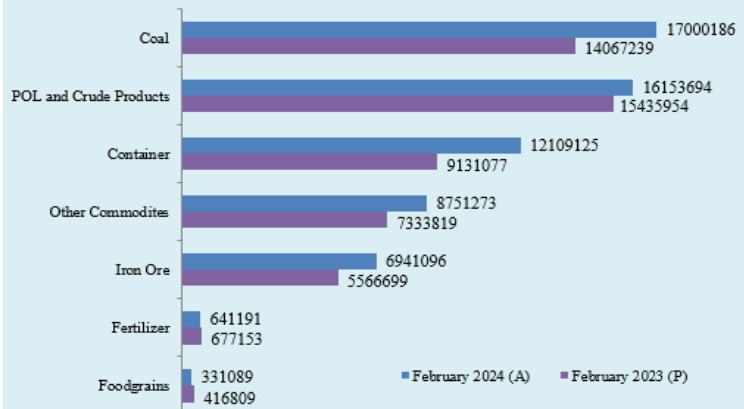
Commodities handled by Non-Major ports

Broadly commodities are categorized in 7 Principal commodities.

Progress in February 2024

- Containers registered maximum (32.61%) growth
- Coal had maximum (27.45%) share in total cargo handled
- POL and Crude Products had 4.65% growth with cargo share of 26.08%
- Growth was negative for Foodgrains (20.57%) and Fertilizer (5.31%)

Chart 5: Principal Commodity-wise Cargo handled in February 2024 vis-à-vis February 2023



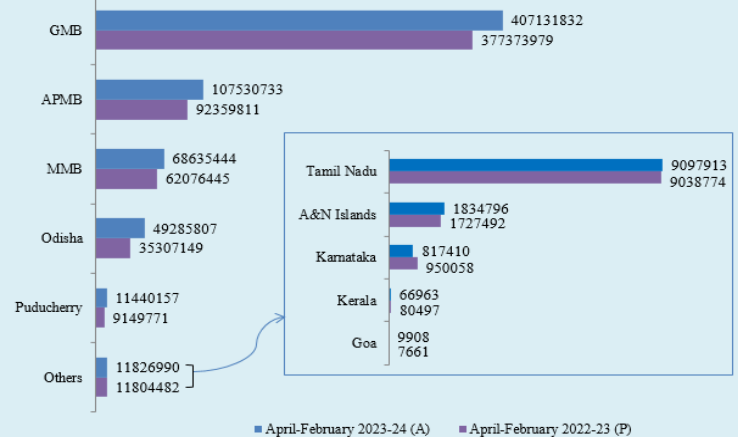

- Others (Goa, Kerala, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, A&N Islands) handled only 11.83 MMT cargo

Chart 6: Cargo handled by Non-Major Ports during April-February 2023-24 vis-à-vis April-February 2022-23



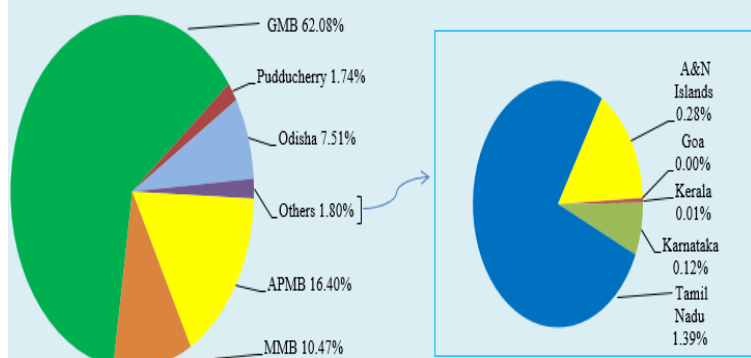

- Top 5 SMB/DoP handled 98.20 % of total cargo
- Maximum cargo handled by Gujarat Maritime Board (62.08 %)
- Others (Goa, Kerala, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and A&N Islands) handled only 1.80 % of total cargo

Commodity-wise Cargo handled and its Growth during April-February 2023-24

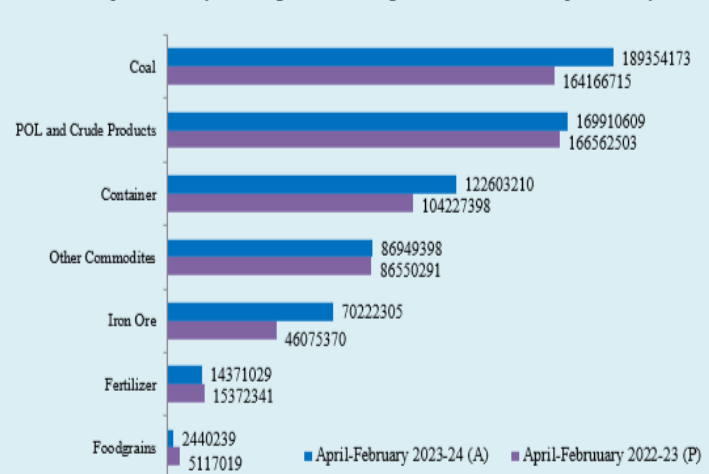
Commodity-wise cargo handled

Broadly commodities are categorized in 7 Principal commodities.

Progress during April-February 2023-24 vis-à-vis April-February 2022-23

- Coal had maximum (28.87%) share in the total cargo handled
- Iron ore registered maximum (52.41%) growth
- Growth is minimum (0.46%) for Other Commodities with cargo share of 13.26%
- Growth is negative for Food grains (52.31%) and Fertilizers (6.51%)

Chart 8: Principal Commodity-wise Cargo handled during April-February vis-à-vis April-February 2022-23



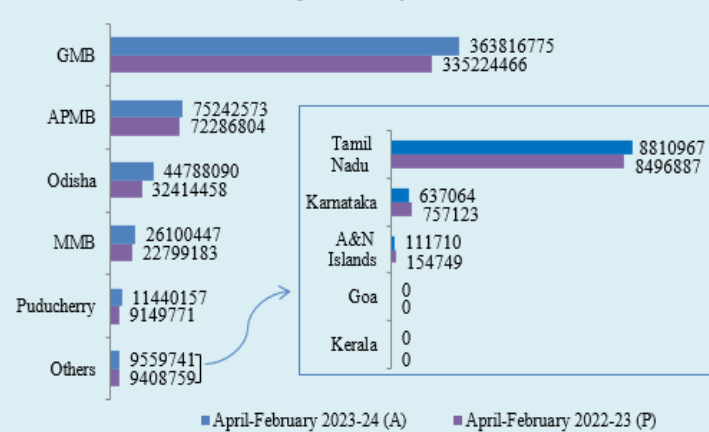

Chart 9: Overseas Cargo handled by Non-Major Ports during April- February 2023-24 vis-a-vis April-February 2022-23



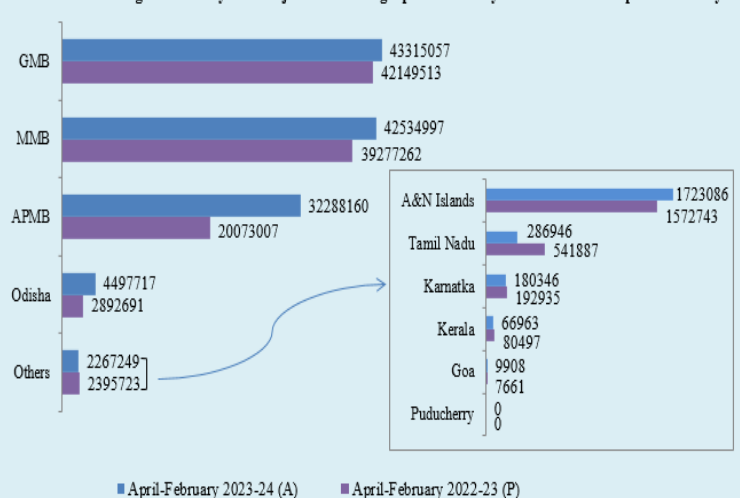
SMB/ DoP-wise Coastal Cargo handled during April-February 2023-24

- Others (Puducherry, Goa, Kerala, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and A&N Islands) handled 1.82% of total cargo

Monthly Cargo Handled by SMB/DoP during April-February 2023-24 vis-a-vis April-February 2022-23

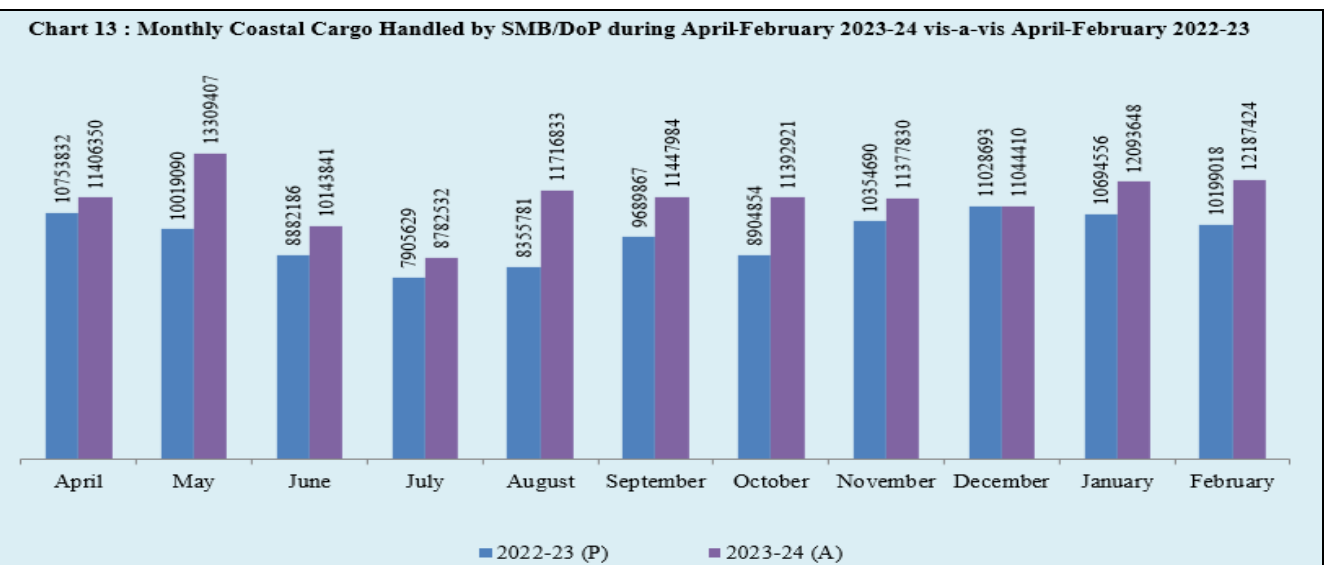
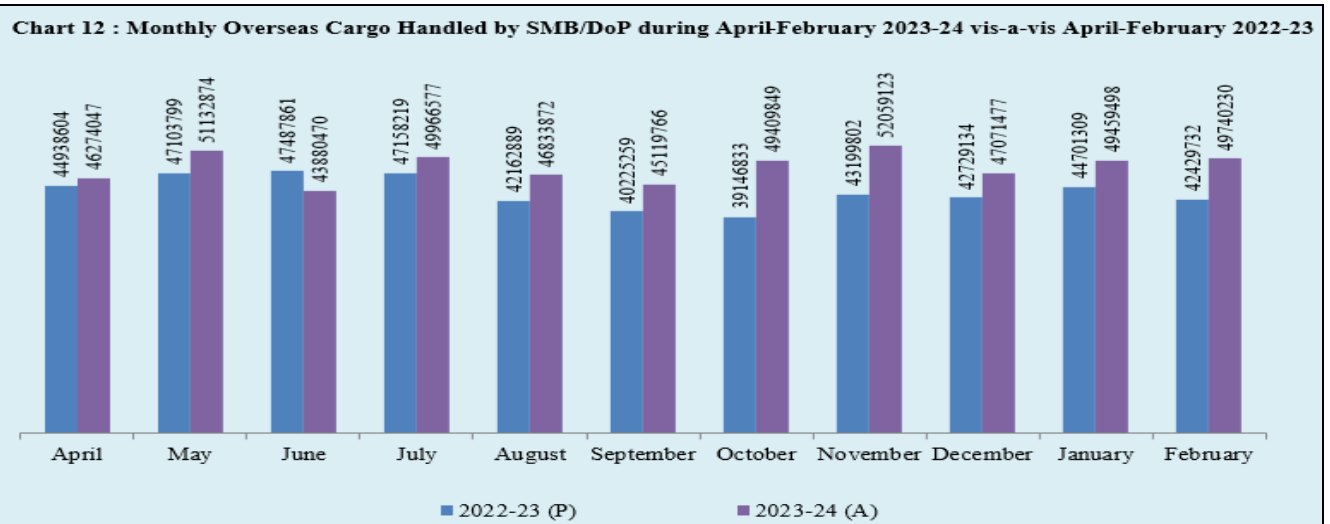
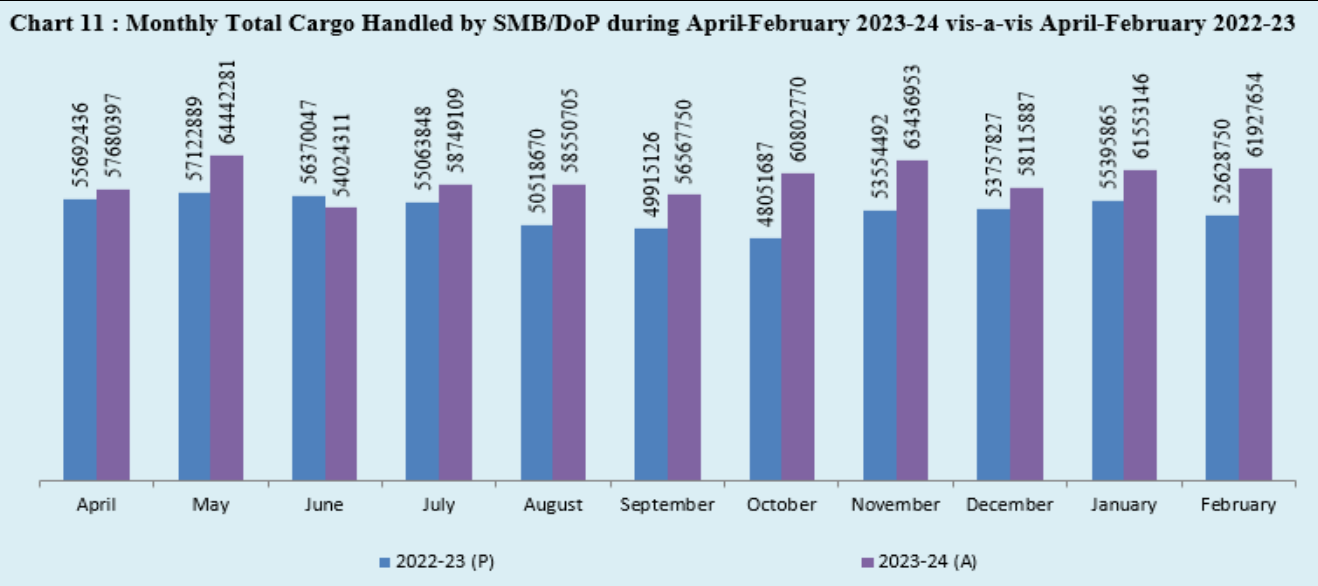
