## Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways Monthly Summary for the month of April 2025

- 1. The **IWAI Digital Portal** for submission of applications for NOC for construction of jetties/terminals on National Waterways was launched on April 9, 2025 by the Hon'ble Minister.
- 2. **Multi-Modal Terminal (MMT) at Haldia** was notified as a 'Customs Area' under Section 8 of the Customs Act, 1962.
- 3. PPP project for "Mechanization of CQ-III berth at Paradip Port" at a total cost of Rs. 451 crore was awarded during the month. This will add capacity of 10 MTPA.
- 4. Key Performance Indicators' (KPI) definitions have been refined & standardized and issued in respect of Major Ports.
- 5. CMA-CGM, the world's third largest container shipping line, registered its container ship in India making it the first global shipping line to register a ship in India. This was flagged-off on April 28, 2025.
- Cruise operations were commenced from the newly built Mumbai International Cruise Terminal (MICT) in Mumbai. This will be India's largest cruise facility to be operated on PPP basis.
- 7. **National Maritime Heritage Complex Society** for management of NMHC at Lothal was registered during the month.
- 8. An MoU was signed between MoPSW and Ministry of Culture, Thailand for collaboration on matters related to Maritime Heritage.
- 9. Procurement through GeM for FY 2024-25 was Rs. 2,659.15 crore against the target of Rs. 2522.39 crore.
