**STEPS TAKEN BY MINISTRY OF SHIPPING FOR PROMOTING
“EASE OF DOING BUSINESS”**

In order to promote trade and improve India’s ranking in the “Trading Across Borders’ indicator of World Bank’s Doing Business Report, Govt. of India has taken significant initiatives such as elimination of manual Form 13 & 11 at Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust w.e.f. 23/02/2015 and developed a software for web based e-Form 13, wherein the Customs authorization/ endorsement is obtained online while accepting the containers. “Gate Automation System” has been put in place at GTI terminal in JNPT, resulting in significant reduction of transaction time at the port gate for containers.
