I am directed to refer to the above mentioned subject and to say that clarifications on PGLM, 2015 issued from time to time were compiled and a consolidated Policy Guidelines for Land Management 2015 incorporating the various clarification was issued vide this Ministry's letter of even No. dated 29th April, 2019

2. Since the clarification circular issued on 29.4.2019 had a sunset clause, reference has been received to extend the validity of the same. The matter has been examined in this Ministry and it is clarified as under:

Since PGLM, 2014 has been approved by the Cabinet, it is valid until it is revised by the Cabinet. Hence, the compiled PGLM, 2015 issued on 29.4.2019 will be applicable for both the land of Major Port Trust and the Township Area subject to conditions mentioned in the letter dated 29.4.2019.
