Invitation for Submission of Offer/Quotation for Website Accessibility Audit of Website of Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways (<https://shipmin.gov.in>).

1. Background:

- a) An accessibility audit is a thorough, professional evaluation of how well a website, mobile application or any other digital system meet the needs of people with disabilities, conform with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG), and comply with legal standards such as Rule 15, sub-rule (1), clause (c), item (i) and (iii) as amended vide MSJE Notification No. G.S.R. 359 (E) dated 10 May, 2023 and comply with the Indian standards IS-17802 (Part 1), 2021 and IS -17802 (Part 2), 2022, published by the Bureau of Indian Standards vide notification number HQ-PUB0131112020-PUB-BIS(278), dated 24thDecember, 2021 and HQ-PUB0131112020-PUB-BIS(358), dated the 4th May, 2022, respectively as amended from time to time.
- b) For compliance with the above, establishments shall get their websites/apps audited for digital accessibility compliance by an accessibility expert **who holds certification from International Association of Accessibility Professionals (IAAP)**, and the government establishments are required to submit STQC certification to the Court of the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities (DIVYANGJAN).

2. Scope of Work: The auditor will assess various accessibility aspects as per WCAG accessibility standards and guidelines as notified under Rule 15 of the Rights of the Persons with Disabilities (RPWD) Rules, specifically IS 17802-Accessibility for ICT Products and Services, and WCAG 2.2 Level AA, including but not limited to:

- (a) Design and ease of navigation using keyboard, screen readers, and other assistive technologies
(b) Usage of Visual indicators
(c) Contrast, colour and font compliance
(d) Availability of text alternatives for images for screen readers
(e) Compatibility with assistive technologies
(f) Accessibility of interactive elements (forms, buttons, etc.)
(g) Error identification and clear instructions for users.

5. **Blacklisting:** Auditors failing to meet the stipulated timelines or refused to undertake the work, run the risk of being blacklisted by the department and further action may be taken by DePWD as the terms and conditions of the empanelment.

6. **Eligibility:** Web Accessibility Auditors empanelled with Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India are allowed to participate in this proposal.

9. **Offer/Quotation Submission:**

(a) Auditors are requested to submit offer/quotations for the defined scope of works and deliverables. The consolidated cost should be provided for the following two stages of testing:

- First detailed testing leading to the audit report; and
- Retesting cum Final Compliance after the site is remediated by the Department's development team.

(b) The role of the auditor is limited to the audit, and all remediation work will be undertaken by the Ministry/Department.

10. **Penalties:**

The Agency has to complete the audit as per timelines defined by this Office. In case of failure to do so, a penalty @ Rs. 500/- per day will be applicable up to two week and thereafter, Rs 1, 000/-per day with maximum ceiling @ 10% of the total cost.

11. **Selection Criteria:**

The selection of the auditor shall be based on the overall financial cost. The bid quoting the lowest total cost shall be considered the most suitable. In the event of two or more bidders quoting identical financial costs, the final decision of the Competent Authority of this Ministry shall prevail and binding on all the concerned, and no claim or representation in this regard shall be entertained.

6. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.
7. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as

defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।/In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
