### **Indian Maritime University** (IMU)

IMU is a Teaching and Affiliating University established on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2008 to provide quality maritime education, training and research. Headquartered in Chennai, it has 7 Regional Campuses at Chennai, Kolkata, Mumbai, Visakhapatnam, Cochin, Kandla and Karaikal. The 3 institutes in Mumbai: *Training Ship Chanakya, Marine Engineering Research Institute, Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Advanced Maritime Studies & Research,* became the Mumbai campus of IMU. The 2 institutes in Kolkata: *Marine Engineering Research Institute & Indian Institute of Port Management* became the Kolkata campus of IMU. The *National Maritime Academy* in Chennai became the Chennai campus of IMU. The *National Ship Design and Research Centre* in Visakhapatnam became the Visakhapatnam campus of IMU. Post-November 2008, 3 new Campuses were set up - in Kochi in 2009, Kandla in 2011 and Karaikal in January 2014. IMU has 37 Affiliated Institutes.

A pass in the CET is **mandatory** for any student to get admitted to IMU, even in an Affiliated Institute. IMU switched over to **Computer-based (Online) CET** on the pattern of IIT-JEE from 2014 onwards. It was a great success. IMU also switched over to **Online Counselling** from 2014 onwards – one of the few universities to do so. It was also a great success. While CET is mandatory, Counselling is optional.

- 5. IMU's Development Plans: IMU is planning to introduce: M.Tech in Marine Engineering in Kolkata and Mumbai Campuses from 2016-17 onwards. M.Sc in Nautical Science in Chennai Campus from 2016-17 onwards. 1-year Executive MBA in Mumbai Campus from 2016-17 onwards. Ph.D in Chennai Campus from 2016-17 onwards and in Mumbai, Kolkata and Kochi Campuses from 2018-19 onwards. Modular courses which combine distance learning and contact classes by which seafarers can acquire new degrees suited to their profession even while on active duty as seafarers. IMU is planning to conduct National Seminars at least once a year on various topics such as Coastal Shipping, Maritime Security, Energy Efficiency, Search and Rescue, Transportation of Dangerous Cargo and other industry-specific topics. A publication will be brought out at the end of each Seminar. This will boost IMU's image in the industry and academia.
- 6. IMU is planning to collaborate with the **World Maritime University** (WMU) and other reputed international universities to run joint MBA and other courses whereby IMU's students will study for a period of 3 months or longer in the foreign university and get a joint degree. IMU is planning to attract **Endowments** for Orations, Awards, Scholarships and Chairs from its alumni or the industry. IMU is planning to tap its alumni for improving the **Placement** prospects of its students.
